HORSEBACK First, try out different horses and saddles. Then take off cross-country - the route you take, the speed you ride, the choice of running, or swimming rivers - you decide this with your Centaura Farms host (in English or Spanish).

NON-RIDERS A Day Back to Simpler Times – Non-riders are welcome to join the real life on an active horse farm, lounge in the hammocks, read a book or swim in the pool, feed the water buffalo, play with the dogs, take off in the old Land Rover to go hiking in the nearby primary forest (yes, with monkeys), or just watch the horses in training.

MEALS Centaura Farms provides lunch, either at the farm or at a local restaurant, as you prefer.

CLOTHING Long pants, socks and strong shoes (tennis shoes are fine) which can get soaking wet (we may cross a few rivers), lightweight shirt, sun block. Centaura Farms will happily loan you a riding helmet or western style hat and rain slicker, saddle bags to carry drinking water and your camera gear -- just ask!



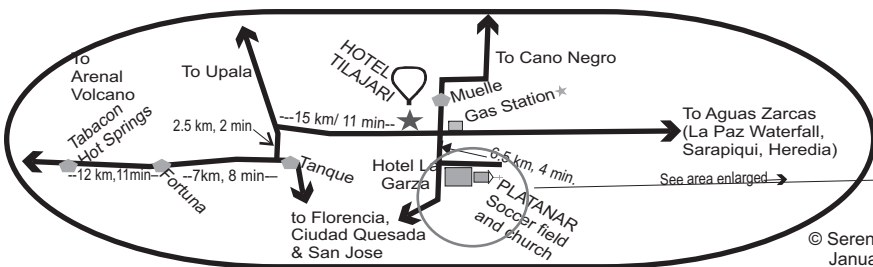
BALLOONING The countryside surrounding our take-off has rainforest, rivers, villages, farms. We try our best to get you close to the earth several times -- for the sheer joy of "swooping" like an eagle.

WHERE TO MEET Serendipity will meet you in Reception of Hotel Tilajari or the gas station at Muelle intersection (see map, below) at the time specified when you make the reservation (normally between 5:00 AM and 5:45 AM, depending on time of sunrise). Serendipity will return you to the hotel after the flight, normally by 9:30 AM.

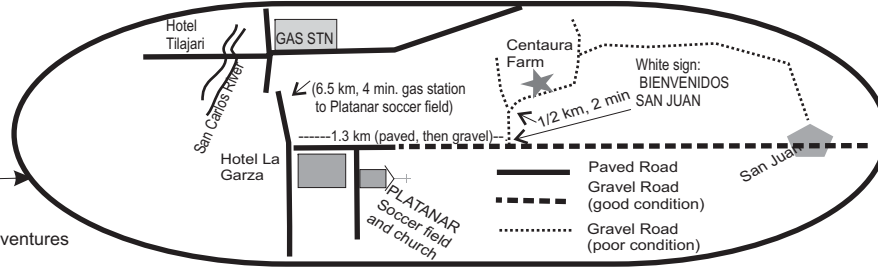
CLOTHING Long pants, **strong shoes** (tennis shoes are fine), lightweight shirt, sun block, baseball style hat (no wide brimmed hats -- they get knocked off!). Temperatures aloft are no colder than on the ground at take-off. Serendipity will provide a bag to

carry drinking water and your camera gear.

AIRCRAFT & PILOTS Maintenance and inspection for our U.S. built CAMERON BALLOONS is performed by Cameron Balloons to FAA requirements. Our pilots hold international (ICAO) pilot licenses for balloons, valid for balloon flight throughout the world.

PHYSICAL CONDITION For your safety we request that you tell us when making your reservation what is your physical condition, including height, weight, any serious medications you are on, or any condition which might cause you pain or injury.

RESERVATIONS required. Reservations are confirmed when the RELEASE has been signed by you and returned (via FAX) to 558-1030, with a credit card payment. In the event we cancel activity for safety (weather) reasons, card will not be charged.

CANCELLATION Must cancel via FAX before 6 PM the day before or the card will be charged.

RELEASE specifies your height, weight, and physical condition. We must receive signed RELEASE to confirm the reservation.

- \$190** Horseback: per person (min. 2)
- \$750** Horseback Charter: from 1 to 5 riders plus friends. Charter assures you have EXCLUSIVE, PRIVATE use of Centaura Farm, trails, and horses for the day.

BALLOONING

- \$345** per person (min. 2 persons)
- \$1200** Private charter (up to 5 people, 800 lbs)

Transfer to-from Arenal area hotel (up to turn for National Park for up to 5 people **\$120**)
Join for day as a non-rider **\$30**
